PRACTICES:

TIMES:

Tuesday and Thursday from approximately 4:45 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. The monthly calendar will show exact practice times and dates. Practices will start on October 19th.

Prime Athletes will be mandatory for players on the 12-1 team. It is open to all other 12 and under players and we encourage them to participate. The workouts will be held after practices for 30 minutes.

LOCATION: The Home Depot Center Velodrome, Carson

TOURNAMENTS:

- **SCVA Tournaments:** All teams in the 12 & under age division will play in all the SCVA mandatory tournaments. There will be approximately two tournaments a month, held in the greater Los Angeles area. Tournament dates are posted at www.scvavolleyball.org.
- **Festival and Junior Olympics:** The 12-1 Team will attend either the Junior Nationals or the Volleyball Festival at the end of the season. The 12-Gold and 12-Blue teams will not attend these tournaments.

Transportation for Travel Tournaments-

PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO ARRANGE AND PAY FOR THEIR OWN TRANSPORTATION TO/FROM TRAVEL TOURNAMENTS. Ground transportation, hotel arrangements and food during the travel tournaments will be provided. Players will be notified as to the travel arrangements for SBVC staff in the event players wish to travel with the coaches.

Prime Athletes

Prime Athletes training will be mandatory for 12-1 team members and highly recommended for all others. The fee is **\$350** for five months of training.

REGISTRATION

Once you have verbally committed to South Bay VBC, a \$500 deposit will be required within 3 days to hold your spot. The deposit becomes non-refundable after the commitment date October 11th. Go to www.southbayvbc.com, click on the Registration link on the home page, and follow the screens to register. You can make the \$500 payment with a credit card online or by mailing in a check.

Once you are notified that you have made the club, there will be a mandatory parent meeting Tuesday, October 19th at 7:30 p.m. at the Velodrome immediately following the first practice.

After the initial deposit of \$500 is paid, you will be put on a payment schedule to pay off the remaining dues. Payments will be made on the 1st of the month December – May and can be made with cash, a check or credit card.
